

## VICTORIA HILL

Victoria Hill wears several hats: as both Principal and Head of Production of the newly-founded Fibonacci Films she is also a working actor and writer.

Hill began her career as one of the founding members of South Australia's prestigious theatre company Brink Productions, where Hill performed and produced new theatrical works as well as commissioning new translations and adaptations of established pieces.

With controversial director Geoffrey Wright (**Romper-Stomper**), Hill co-wrote the screenplay and co-produced the film **Macbeth**, a contemporary Australian retelling of William Shakespeare's play set in the ganglands of Melbourne. Hill also starred as Lady Macbeth opposite Sam Worthington's Macbeth. The film screened at the 2006 Toronto International Film Festival.

Hill has starred in numerous other film and television productions including: **December Boys** alongside Daniel Radcliffe and Jack Thompson, **Hunt Angels** opposite Ben Mendelsohn and the comedy film **BoyTown** with Mick Molloy. More recently Victoria played Jo in directors Anthony Mir's comedy **Manny Lewis** and played Naomi in the crime thriller **Soul**.

In 2017, Hill produced and stars in **The Chaperone**, based on Laura Moriarty's best-selling novel and adapted for the screen by Academy Award®-winning writer Julian Fellowes. She also produced the provocative and critically acclaimed feature film **First Reformed**, from iconic screenwriter/director Paul Schrader. Hill stars opposite Ethan Hawke in the pivotal role of his estranged wife Esther.

Most recently Victoria is producing and starring as Claire in feature film **The Secrets We keep** with director Yuval Adler. The feature film **Buckley's Chance** with Victoria starring as Gloria is currently in post production.
