Previously, they toured internationally in 2024 as Bluey in *Bluey's Big Play*. Ursula was nominated for a Green Room Award for her portrayal of Medium Alison in the Melbourne Theatre Company (MTC) production of *Fun Home* in 2022. In 2019 Ursula performed in, stage managed and directed opera with the Berlin Opera Academy.
