In his graduating year he was able to perform in a small ensemble, self devised project called 'Exquisite Corpse 3.0' where Andrew used his writing and choreographic skills to create a multitude of stories. Andrew specializes in Choreography in different styles, Primarily in Tap and commercial genres, as well as helping in creating contemporary dance styled routine for the TOGETHER project which celebrated the grand opening of the Gippsland Performing Arts Centre in Traralgon Victoria in 2022. Andrew has completed up to 'Elementary Seal' in the Australian Teachers of Dancing (A.T.O.D) Tap syllabus. Danceworks 114 Traralgon, Victoria.

Andrew identifies as a queer, gender fluid artist. Playing both male and female roles in the past. A notable female role would be the character 'Karen' in Ragamuffin's Christmas, directed by Phil A. Mayer in 2018. Andrew has also performed as a Drag Performer for small scale festivals, a notable festival includes 'Outback Fest' which took place annually from 2021-2023 in Ballarat, Victoria. Using both dance and Acting skills to create different engaging stories. Andrew also competed in 'Piano Bar's Got Talent, Ballarat' progressing to the grand final. He has also stepped his foot in corporate entertainment as a 'Myer Elf' for Myer's Santaland during the 2022 and 2023 Christmas period.

Andrew has a valid Working with Children's check and understanding of AUSLAN (Australian Sign Language). When Andrew is not onstage, you can see him in the kitchen cooking up a storm.
