Hotere earned FRINGE Festival's Outstanding Actress and Outstanding Writer awards, while *Skin Hunger* also received the PANZ Pitching Award and Outstanding Director. She will perform in *Skin Hunger*'s second season at Q theatre from Feb 7th-10th 2023.
