

ROSS DANIELS – BIOGRAPHY

Ross has been a prominent figure in the Australian entertainment industry for over 30 years.

His more recent theatre performances include the multi-award winning inaugural production of *Bighouse Dreaming* (Melbourne Fringe). Ross received a Green Room nomination for his performance in this production and was co-winner for Best Ensemble. He's also been seen in Riot Stage's *F*, *Mermaid Baby* (Jala Festival), *Unpack This* and *The Scrunch Test*.

In 2018 Ross appeared in the hit feature film *That's Not My Dog*.

He has guest starred in several TV dramas and comedies including *Jack Irish*, *City Homicide*, *Lowdown* and the ABC telemovie *Cliffy*. Ross also featured in the award-winning episode of *Round the Twist*: 'The Tears of Innocence'.

His short film *There's No Place* [writer, actor, co-director] won multiple awards at film festivals in Australia and overseas.

Among Ross's extensive stage appearances he has performed in over 20 different productions for the Melbourne International Comedy Festival. Of these several have been his one person shows including the acclaimed *Punked* and *The Transposed Man* (nominated Best Comedy, Adelaide Fringe). He premiered his latest solo show *One Small Trip* at The Butterfly Club in 2019.

He was also an original, core cast member of the popular improvised musical SPONTANEOUS BROADWAY (The Comedy Theatre, Spiegeltent, Arts Centre Melbourne, Edinburgh Fringe).
