Tiarnie Coupland was recently seen on the ABC Australia series JACK IRISH starring Guy Pearce. Tiarnie plays "Gus", a neglected teen in need of a parental figure, who develops a close bond with Pearce's character. She previously completed shooting a series regular role on the acclaimed Australian television series LOVE CHILD for Nine Network. This follows the lives of staff and residents at Sydney's fictional Kings Cross Hospital and Stanton House – a home for unwed mothers – in 1969. Tiarnie starred as "Maggie Prentice", a full-on wild child who was given up for adoption in 1955. Her critically-acclaimed performance earned her a Logie Award nomination for Best New Talent. Film credits include Damien Power's 2017 Sundance Film Festival selection KILLING GROUND, Xan Cassavetes' vampire indie film KISS OF THE DAMNED with Milo Ventimiglia, Australian sci-fi feature THE HALF DEAD opposite John Rhys-Davies, acclaimed Australian indie drama THE FINAL WINTER and the short film FRANSWA SHARL opposite Callan McAuliffe which won the prestigious Crystal Bear Best Short Film Award at the 2010 Berlin International Film Festival.
