Their directorial debut *Pieces of Us* (EdFringe) was Offie-nominated, and they serve as Movement Consultant for Lionwoman Productions Texas. After fourteen years living abroad, they have recently returned home to Melbourne, where in December 2025 they will appear as Touchstone in *As You Like It* with Melbourne Shakespeare Company.
