Adrienne Pickering's extensive acting career spans both stage and screen. She is best known for the leading role of Missy opposite Richard Roxburgh in all five seasons of the highly acclaimed ABC series Rake, as well as her powerful portrayal of Eileen Bond in the Nine Network's mini-series House of Bond.

Adrienne's Australian feature film work includes director Neil Armfield's Candy, the role of Jane in director James Rabbitts' The Clinic, and the role of Susie in The Reef from directed by Andrew Traucki.

Adrienne's many TV credits include lead roles on Network Seven's series Headland and All Saints and Channel Ten's series Secrets & Lies, as well as guest lead roles in Operation Buffalo for writer/director Peter Duncan for the ABC, House Husbands and Sea Patrol for the Nine Network, Offspring, My Life is Murder, Mr & Mrs Murder, Out of the Blue and Neighbours for TEN, Home & Away for Seven, and Ronny Chieng: International Student, Dr Blake and It's A Date. Adrienne can currently be seen in the series Darby & Joan for Acorn TV, Barrumbi Kids for NITV and Surviving Summer (season 1 and 2) for Netflix.

Adrienne's US TV credits include Reef Break for US ABC Network.

Adrienne also played the role of Zoya in Company B/Belvoir's sell out season of Ruben Guthrie, opposite Toby Schmitz and directed by Wayne Blair.

Adrienne won the Best Actor award from the Pacific Film and Television Commission – Warner Roadshow Studios, New Filmmakers Awards for her work in the short film She Was Quiet.
