Rachel's acting has been nominated for awards in various competitions throughout her career. The short film Tallebudgera Road won "Best Film" at Melbourne Lift Off Festival in 2022, and she was a finalist in the 2014 Actors Process Scholarship.

Rachel's cast credits include films, *Bloody Hell*, and *Australian Day*, as well as the TV Series *Harrow* as Detective Tina Stolz. She featured in *Thor Ragnarok*, *Escape From Spiderhead* and *Joe v/s Carole*.

Rachel's Theatre credits include touring with Shakespeare companies, *Grin and Tonic* and *Power of Will* TIE theatre company. She also toured with the *Big Toe Theatre Company*, with the show *Sludge Crossing*, which was used as a tool to help prevent the alarming rising rates of teenage suicide in our country.

Rachel has a postgraduate degree in Drama Education. She encourages art to be used as a weapon to provoke thought and change. Rachel has also Produced and created the "choose your own adventure series" *Scrap*, an engaging and interactive show where the audience can decide which way the story plays out.
