She founded Transcend Australia and has been a central voice in legal, educational and medical reforms supporting the human rights of trans and gender diverse children and their families. She has been a patron of Wear It Purple Day, spoken at RMIT University, the Law Society of Victoria, Australian Football League, Casey City Council, LUSH, Igniting Change, and spoke at a Senate Estimates Hearing at the Parliament of Australia. She appeared alongside her daughter in the Netflix documentary [The Dreamlife of Georgie Stone](#) which was nominated for a Peabody Award in 2022.
