Joel Jackson is a Minang Noongar man from the Wagyl Kaip region. Joel was born on Minang country and raised on Ngarluma and Yindjibarndi country in WA's brilliantly vibrant Pilbara region. A Logie and Australian Academy of Cinema and Television Arts award winning actor, musician and writer, best known for his triple threat TV role in *Peter Allen; Not the Boy Next Door*, Joel's numbering TV credits also include *Deadline* Gallipoli, *Hyde & Seek, The Wrong Girl*, International Emmy Award Winning Series *Safe Harbour, Mystery Road 2, The Claremont Murders* and *Ms Fisher's Modern Murder Mysteries* and the upcoming *Scrublands; Season 2*. Joel's feature film credits include *I Met A Girl*, CinefestOz Film Prize Winner; *H is for Happiness, Jungle* starring opposite Daniel Radcliffe, the 2024 Adelaide Film Festival closing night film *Kangaroo Island*, and the current nominees for Best Feature and Best Independent Feature respectively at the 2025 AACTA Awards *Runt* and *Just A Farmer*.
