Stephen Hunter's extensive acting career spans both film and television.

Stephen's major international screen role was as the Dwarf Bombur in all three of Peter Jackson's The Hobbit films: An Unexpected Journey, The Hobbit: The Desolation of Smaug and The Hobbit: The Battle of Five Armies.

Stephen worked extensively in NZ television before landing the role of Sharpie in the Australian Network Ten's series Love My Way, followed by lead guest roles on Seven Network's All Saints, Network Nine's Rescue Special Ops, as well as series lead roles on ABC's Janet King, Seven's Home & Away, Wolf Creek for STAN, and Wanted for Netflix. Stephen was a series regular in the role of Otter in the ABC Studios (US) series, Reef Break, alongside Poppy Montgomery and starred opposite Rebecca Gibney in Network Nine's Halifax Retribution.

Stephen's other TV credits include roles on Nickelodeon's The GO Show, ABC comedies Review with Miles Barlow and Rosehaven, Foxtel's Spirited, The Leftovers for HBO, The Internet for Jungle TV, the NZ series Fresh Eggs, the ABC animated series CJ the DJ and Parent Up, also for the ABC.

Stephen's feature film credits include the New Zealand WW1 film Field Punishment No.1 and the Australian films; Killing Ground, The Merger, the lead role of Madcap in the sci-fi action adventure Blue World Order opposite Billy Zane, Jack Thompson and Bruce Spence, as well as the Australian/Indian feature UNindian, the Australian/Chinese feature The Whistleblower, the thriller Escape from Pretoria alongside Daniel Radcliffe, the comedy/horror feature Two Heads Creek with Kerry Armstrong and the short film MESSiAH opposite David Gulpilil, as well as the US horror feature Children of the Corn for director Kurt Wimmer.

Stephen was also nominated for Best Supporting Actor, by Film Critics Circle of Australia, for his portrayal of Doug in the feature film Ruby's Choice, starring alongside Jane Seymour, Jacqueline McKenzie & Coco Jack Gillies.

Stephen's latest credits include leading roles in the BBC series Wakefield, the HBO Max series The Tourist, the Nine Network series After the Verdict, the Netflix series Heartbreak High, the ABC's Barons, the ABC drama series The Messenger, BBC & Stan's Ten Pound Poms; as well as the US feature Thor; Love and Thunder.

Stephen will next be seen in the BBC Studios Productions series Return To Paradise; a spinoff of the popular long running series Death In Paradise.
