ABOUT KORINNA

Korinna Gouros is an Australian actor, comedian, and writer whose work finds the humour in chaos and the beauty in contradiction. Drawing on her Greek-Australian upbringing and queer identity, she crafts stories that are equal parts raw, witty, and culturally sharp, balancing vulnerability with fearless humour. Her work blends confessional storytelling with theatrical absurdity - a mix of sharp wit, emotional honesty, and playful chaos.

Her debut comedy solo *Sorry My Mum Won't Let Me* premiered at Sydney Fringe 2025 to strong audiences, following her original one-woman theatre work *Self-Raising Flower* at Melbourne Fringe 2024. On screen, she's appeared in *Amazing Grace* (Nine Network), *The Invisibles* (SBS), and campaigns for Google, Lilydale, and the Royal Australian Air Force.



A graduate of UNSW (Theatre & Performance), Korinna has since trained with Ben Matthews of Acting Mastery and Kim Farrant. She's performed at The Comedy Store, the Greek Festival of Sydney Youth Comedy Gala, and the Laugh Inn in line-ups such as *Wicked Women* and *Chaos Comedy*.

Known for her sharp honesty and commanding stage presence, Korinna is carving out her place as one of Australia's most distinctive new talents - a fearless performer and storyteller bringing authenticity and originality to both stage and screen.

ARTIST STATEMENT

Korinna's work is rooted in the grit and absurdity of real life. Raised in a low-income home shaped by control and chaos, she found survival and connection through humour. Her storytelling explores identity, resilience, and the quiet forces that shape us.

WHAT'S NEXT?

Korinna is bringing both of her original stage shows to Adelaide Fringe 2025, followed by a planned season at the Melbourne International Comedy Festival 2026.

Her debut short film, an adaptation of her acclaimed play *Self-Raising Flower*, is currently in development, with Korinna attached as writer and lead actor.

She is set to co-direct and develop the project under the mentorship of writer-director Sanjay De Silva (*Maalu*, *Final Form by Sampa The Great*; Google, NBA, Adidas, Flybuys, IKEA).
