Olivia grew up in Melbourne Australia, she trained in drama, dance and singing and started her professional career at 12 years old playing Tamara Noodle in the multi international award winning ABC children's comedy television series 'Little Lunch' and later the Little Lunch Specials.

She then moved to Sydney when she won a role on Australia's highest rating drama series 'Home and Away' for the 7 Network. She played the very popular Raffy Morrison for three years in over 287 episodes. During her time on the show Olivia won a Nickelodeon Kids Choice Award (the famous Orange blimp and the privilege of being slimed) in the category of Favourite Rising Star.

4 days after finishing her *Home and Away* contract, Olivia flew to Canada to commence filming the Disney+ film, *Secret Society of Second Born Royals*, starring as Princess Roxana. The film was released on Disney + in 2020.

Also a talented writer, Olivia wrote, associate produced and played the role of Charlotte in the award winning teen drama series 'More Than This', which premiered on Paramount+ in 2022. Passionate about creating and portraying an authentic Australian high school experience, she wrote the series through the Melbourne lockdowns while still completing her last year of high school. The show received rave reviews and went on to win 2 awards at the Chicago International Children's festival and has been nominated for 3 further awards in Australia and Internationally. Olivia was then nominated and became a finalist in the 7NEWS Young Achiever of the Year Awards. The show is used as a resource for teachers and students all over the country through the 'Australian Children's Television Fund' education program; especially in the areas of respectful consent, relationships and gender identity.

In 2024 Olivia made her theatre debut in the lead role of Molly in *Peter And The Starcatcher*, which toured Australia's capital cities in 2024/25 to rave reviews.
