Phoebe Tonkin

Phoebe Tonkin has built a hugely successful acting career both in Australia and Internationally, and is perhaps best known for her lead role in The CW Network's supernatural series *The Originals*, currently filming it's third season in Atlanta.

In film, Phoebe starred as Fiona in the box office hit based on the international best seller *Tomorrow When The War Began* for Paramount Pictures and the feature film *Bait*, which she plays leading role opposite Xavier Samuel and Julian McMahon. *Bait* has been the most successful Australian movie ever released in China. In 2014, Phoebe began filming Jim Gillespie's upcoming feature film TAKE DOWN opposite Ed Westwick and Jeremy Sumpter and in 2015 starred as Mabel in Mark Webber's feature film *The Ever After*, opposite Teresa Palmer.

Phoebe's television work includes a lead series role in CW Network's US series THE SECRET CIRCLE and a recurring lead role in the hugely successful THE VAMPIRE DIARIES from the same network. Most recently, she completed a guest role on CBS television drama series *Stalker* as Nicole Clark.

Phoebe's guest roles on Australian television include successful TV series *Packed To The Rafters* and *Home & Away*, both for the Seven Network.

Phoebe's is best known domestically for her leading role of Cleo Sertori in the enormously successful international Australian teen TV series *H2O – Just Add Water* that screened in over 120 territories world wide. Phoebe's portrayal of Cleo saw her nominated for an AFI Best Actress in a TV Drama award for her work on H2O SERIES 2.

Phoebe's theatre credits include the role of Helena in Shakespeare's A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM (Australian Theatre for Young People), as well as the role of Don Pedro in MUCH ADO ABOUT NOTHING (ATYP).
