

Josh Reckless is a Green Room Award Nominated Actor/Singer/Dancer from North Western Sydney NSW. After graduating high school in 2015 Josh was accepted into the prestigious Music Theatre course at the Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts (WAAPA). During his time at WAAPA he played multiple lead roles, including Ralph in Nigel William's stage production of William Golding's *Lord of the Flies*, Bandleader and Andrew Jackson Cover in *Bloody Bloody Andrew Jackson*, and Dennis in *Sunday in the Park with George*.

Josh made his professional debut in 2019 with Storeyboard Productions, playing the role of General Tom Thumb in Tyran Parke's production of *Barnum* at the Comedy Theatre in Melbourne. Sandie Eldridge), Fector and Boland Cover in The Mitchell Old Company's *Dogfight* (dir. Madi Lee - Cancelled due to COVID), and his Green Room Nominated performance of Zachariah in the new Australian work; *The Beep Test Musical* with Melbourne and Adelaide Fringe (dir. Jackson Peele).
