In 2024, Julian Curtis toured with 'Gaslight' (QT), was on stage for Playlab in 'Horizon' (nominated for a Matilda) and made his directorial debut with 'The Norman Mailer Anecdote' at Queensland Theatre. In 2022, he was the villain on the U.S limited series 'Are You Afraid of the Dark: Ghost Island' (Emmy nominated for Outstanding Children's Series); and his upcoming film releases include the lead role in Australian thriller 'First Moon', and supporting in US civil war drama 'Battle of Bushy Run'.

As a writer, Julian has been produced twice by Screen Queensland: 'Power the Kid' (w/ QPIX) and 'And the Winner Is'. 'Tallest Poppies', a web series he co-wrote and acted in, was awarded as finalist at the world's most prestigious comedy festival Just for Laughs Montreal in 2013. His debut play 'Legacy' started life when on salary at University of Queensland before being accepted into the National Workshop via Playwriting Australia. It was performed at LaBoite HWY in 2019.

He is currently prepping to direct '*The Long Passeggiata*'; an ambitious proof of concept film detailing the 1960s Italian migrant experience of the proxy wives.
