Hannah Camilleri is quickly gaining a rep. as one of the most enchanting sketch comedy performers in Melbourne. After being awarded the Golden Gibbo, for the eponymous Pét-Nat + Han ah Chocolat show for the 2021 Melbourne International Comedy Festival, with comedy crush, Nat Harris, and being nominated for Best in Comedy and winning Comedy New Work award at 2022 Melbourne Fringe, Hannah's had countless invitations from Comedy Republic (Replay Festival, Crab Lab, Plague of Idiots and How To Teach Your Dog To Read) and the Comedy Festival itself (Festival Club, Vic Jam, Comedy at The Espy and Roadshow in NSW).

As well as garnering praise for her live performances ('Camilleri's chameleonic ability...[is]a delight to witness' The Age), Hannah created a lockdown web series, Little Shits, nominated for Best Short at Melbourne Women in Film Festival, plays the lead in two successful MIFF shorts, Jeanette Is The Dog (2021) and Lime Parfait (2022) and was the voice of Sister Dimpna on Randy Feltface's TV, Special, Purple Privilege.

So, it would seem Hannah's at home: on stage (Lolly Bag); on screen (The InBESTigators (Netflix), Mr.Black, Playing For Keeps); and on air (Triple R, 'Mom' for Micky Moo (YouTube Kids)).
