GREG KENNEDY

Greg Kennedy is an Australian Actor, Writer and Theatre Director.

Born in the NSW Outback town of Werris Creek with a heritage of both Scottish and Australian Indigenous Aborigine, he was fortunate to spend his teenage years in a typical Australian Beachside town, Surfing, playing Rugby League and Tennis.

Upon leaving School he commenced a Carpentry & Joinery apprenticeship that eventually progressed to specialised in high end Design Hospitality Bars and Restaurants & Project Management. He spent time as a Police Officer in his younger years, becoming a Tactical Response Group Commander. He returned to corporate life and remains active as a Company Director & Consulting Project Manager.

Being called to acting in his 30's, Greg's original debut was in Network 7's long running medical drama All Saints a few months after completing his first year in a part time acting class, located in the basement of a church in Sydney's bohemian Kings Cross. The school doubled as an homeless soup kitchen during the day, acting school during the evenings. Later roles in Films, TV and theatre playing a wide range of character roles.

Supported by his intrinsic strength of Character, Greg naturally performed Leading Man Roles extensively in theatre, corporate improvised role play, performing the 1 man show VINCENT originally and written and performed by the late Leonard Nimoy of Startrek fame. Also performing the Classic Lead Roles of Torvald (Henrik Ibsen's - A Dolls House), George Haverstick (Tennessee Williams – Period of Adjustment), Dafydd Ap Llewellyn (Alan Ayckbourn's – A Chorus of Disapproval) and others.

Spending a number of years pounding the pavements of Hollywood, in which Greg describes and the most wonderful school of life and storytelling, Greg won a Golden Dragon- Best Actor Award in the 2017 Ferrara Film Festival for his performance in RAIN shot in Downtown Los Angeles.
