Kate Elder is a UK-born and bred, and 25year plus West Australian actress known for her enthusiasm and dedication to screen and theatre performances across both dramatic and comedic roles. Her naturally curious nature and commitment to delivering truthful work has seen her land supporting roles in two upcoming Australian feature films.

In the psychological thriller, "The Killing Dark", which will be screened on Netflix and Paramount+ following an international theatrical distribution in 2024, Kate takes on the challenging role of Mrs. Pennybaker, the wheelchair-bound, but concerned neighbour of the evil antagonists. And in the unnerving horror anthology, "Anxiety", Kate inhabits the role of a rural police sergeant faced with the challenge of solving the mysterious disappearances of a local family.

Kate Elder's other recent work highlights her talent and versatility as an actor. In the 2022 short film "Resistance", she received both a Best Actress nomination and award for her portrayal of the Captain. Her ability to embody strong and authoritative characters was further showcased as the Duchess of York in the 2023 New Fortune Theatre production of Shakespeare's Richard III. Kate also earned the Best Actress award for her role as Lady M in the 2021 "Short & Sweet Festival."

Kate is a founding and ongoing member of the Perth Actors Centre Advanced Studio and undertakes ongoing scene study opportunities to continually improve her craft.

Due to also having a career in media and marketing for over 25 years, Kate is very familiar with the pace and diversity of creative production environments.
