Louis Hunter's international acting career spans both stage and screen.

Louis can most recently be seen in the SBS TV series *On The Ropes* starring opposite Keisha Castle-Hughes (WHALE RIDER) and Jack Thompson (THE GREAT GATSBY) and 2017 was seen in the lead role of "Paris" in the eight-part BBC / Netflix series *Troy: Fall Of A City* for writer David Farr (THE NIGHT MANAGER) and director Owen Harris (BLACK MIRROR).

Prior to *Troy*, Louis starred in the psychological thriller *Jack Goes Home* opposite Rory Culkin, Britt Robertson and Natasha Lyonne, which premiered at the 2016 SXSW Film Festival and was released by Momentum Pictures. Louis stars in the indie *The Honor Farm*, which premiered at the 2017 SXSW Film Festival, and in *Killing Animals*, based on the novel by James Franco, who also stars in this portrait of a lost generation of California youths.

Louis' TV credits include *The Fosters* for FreeForm, *Red Band Society* for Fox, *The Secret Circle* for The CW and the BBC Australia series *Out Of The Blue*.

Louis is a classically trained theatre actor who played opposite Cate Blanchett in the Sydney Theatre Company production of *War Of The Roses* as well as *Romeo & Juliet* at the Shakespeare Youth Festival.
