## Ian Stenlake

Ian Stenlake is one of the most sought after performers in Australian film, television and theatre.

His television credits include the Series Lead role of Mike Flynn in *Sea Patrol* for Channel 9, the series lead role of Oscar Stone in *Stingers* as well as the lead role of James in *Children's Hospital* for ABC TV and a guest role in successful ABC series *Dance Academy 2*.

Ian's film credits include the Lead roles of Anthony in *Dingles Down Under*, John in *Diana & Me* opposite Toni Collette, Tug Medic in *Trapped in Space* as well as a role in *The Godfather III* directed by Francis Ford Coppola.

Ian has starred in many successful theatrical musicals including Michael Walsh in *The School of Arts* for Queensland Theatre Company, Sid in *The Pyjama Game* for The Production Company, Cliff in *Cabaret* for IMG Entertainment, Hatter in *Charters Towers* for QLD Musical Festival, Peter Lalor in *Eureka* for S. Gallagher & M. Harvey, as well as roles in *Songs for a New World* for Adelaide Cabaret Festival, *They're Playing Our Song* for The Production Company, *Music Hall* for Royal Shakespeare Theatre and *Angry Housewives* for La Boite/Seymour. In 2013 Ian reprised the role of Curly in Harvest Rain Theatre Company's production *Oklahoma!* before starring again in Harvest Rain's production of *Guys & Dolls* in 2014. Later that year Ian starred in Hayes Theatre Company's production of *Truth, Beauty & a Picture of You*.

Ian's other theatre work includes Prince Charming in the Malthouse Theatre's production of *Sleeping Beauty*, the Narrator in *Carnival of the Animals* for Joan Sutherland Performing Arts Centre, Carton and Darney in *A Tale of Two Cities* Grin & Tonic Theatre Company, Ely, Grey and Pistol in *Henry V* for Household Words Productions, Capulet in *Romeo & Juliet* for Celebrational Theatre Company, Paris and Prince in *Romeo & Juliet* for EHJ Productions and *Walkabout* for Chamber Made Opera. In 2014, Ian starred in Darlinghurst Theatre Company's production of *Daylight Saving* and most recently starred in Griffin Theatre's *Caress/Ache*, which received rave reviews.

Ian has won many awards throughout his career. He is a two time Green Room Awards Winner for Best Male Artist in a Leading Role in 2004 for the production *They're Playing Our Song* and again in 2006 for *Oklahoma!*. He also received two Green Room nominations for Best Male Actor in a Musical for *Cabaret* and *Eureka*.

Ian has been a regular guest on Network Ten's GMA as a vocalist as well as a guest on many other live television shows such as *Carols by Candlelight*. Ian also has extensive experience headlining corporate events and performed as a member of the group *Bravo*.

He just completed in 2015/2016 the role of John Ashby in the hit production *Georgy Girl*.
