She has several TVC credits as the 100% talent in the Federation University *Open Day Campaigns* and *Destination Ballarat Campaigns* — both directed by Charlie Fofu, the *We're with you Campaign* — directed by Greta Nash—and the *Preference Campaign*—directed by Luke Keys.
