After working extensively in New Zealand with roles on films The Last Tattoo opposite Rod Steiger and Paramount Picture's Without a Paddle to starring in TV series Rude Awakenings, Xena: Warrior Princess, Legend of the Seeker and The Cult, Danielle then quickly came to prominence in Australia with her powerhouse performance as Kate Leigh in the acclaimed series Underbelly: Razor, before going on to play the iconic role of Bea Smith in internationally successful series Wentworth, and a role for which Danielle has many prestigious acting awards. Other high profile Australian TV productions followed including Rake, The Secrets She Keeps, Secret City, My Life is Murder, Jack Irish and Fresh Eggs for which she received the Most Outstanding Lead Actress award at the NZ Film & TV Awards. Danielle's most recent work includes the critically acclaimed STAN series Year Of and will next be seen in SBS's Erotic Stories opposite Kate Box.

Danielle's stage performances include productions of Who's Afraid at Belvoir St Theatre for 25a, a production she also co-produced, Hedda for QTC, The Misanthrope for Bell Shakespeare Company, and Boys Will Be Boys at the Sydney Theatre Company.

Danielle directed the stage production Every Brilliant Thing for Silo Theatre which had a national tour in 2021 and she is the co-owner and co-producer of Four One One Productions in Australia.
