

**Leigh Parker** is an Australian actor whose film and television credits include Jean-Marc Vallée's Oscar-nominated feature *Wild* opposite Reese Witherspoon; *Castle*, guest-starring as Lucas Troy alongside Nathan Fillion and Stana Katic; and the CW's *Supernatural*. He starred as Ed in the Netflix original *The Open House* with Dylan Minnette, and appeared as Randall in *The Funhouse Massacre* with horror legend Robert Englund. His feature debut as Manchester 'Manny' Mankiewicz in the teen horror-comedy *All Cheerleaders Die* had its international premiere in Midnight Madness at the Toronto International Film Festival.

Recent credits include the feature films *The Water Village* and *Rebound*, the web series *The Break Room*, and short films *Uncle Lee*, *Extraordinary Rob*, *First Flight*, and *Lured*.

Originally from the Sunshine Coast, Queensland, Leigh spent close to a decade based in Los Angeles before returning home to Australia. He trained extensively in LA under some of the industry's most respected coaches, including Leigh Kilton-Smith, Margie Haber, and Larry Moss.

Leigh now runs the Leigh Parker Acting Studio on the Sunshine Coast, where he coaches the next generation of Australian screen actors.
