Building on 20 years of swing dancing, Sandy trained and performed for a year with Swing Patrol's all-girl solo Charleston dance troupe *The Bluebellies*.

Sandy maintains a connection to community through volunteer participation in the Equity Foundation's *Storyville* program, exploring all manner of voices and characters reading weekly stories to primary school children.

Furthering her training, in 2015 Sandy completed an intensive program at Atlantic Acting School in New York, with a follow-up 5-day intensive by visiting Atlantic teachers in Melbourne in 2016.

She continues to build her knowledge and skill through regular training that has included physical theatre, stage combat, voiceover, US accent and TV presenting.
