Marie-Eve Cigna is a Canadian-Australian actor with Italian heritage. She grew up in Montreal, Canada, with French as her first language. A former elite swimmer, she is a graduate of WAAPA's Bachelor of Performing Arts (2024) and has worked across stage and screen, with credits including Charles Mee's *Big Love*, directed by Candy Bowers, and the role of Rosie in *Things I Know to be True* at Melville Theatre, winner of Best Play at the Finley Awards. She has also appeared in short films selected for Revelation Film Festival and WA Made Film Festival, as well as commercial work for Murdoch University and P&N Bank.

Alongside her work as an actor, Marie-Eve develops her projects across film and theatre. She notably wrote and starred in the short film *Cashing In* (2027 festival release), directed the new play *Dirty Talk* at the Blue Room Theatre in 2026, and was shortlisted for Australians in Film's Untapped 2025 initiative for the feature film *Simple Matters*, which she is co-writing.
