Daya Czepanski is a trans nonbinary actor, artist and LGBT advocate based in Sydney. Hailing from Auckland, New Zealand, Daya is the eldest of seven siblings and spent part of their childhood overseas, then travelling around NZ in campervans. Always creatively inclined, when the family returned to Auckland, Daya began attending community drama classes and took part in their first production in 2013. After spending the next couple of years working across different youth companies, Daya moved to Australia in 2016 to attend NIDA's BFA (acting) and graduated with the class of 2018. Since graduating they have been working as a multidisciplinary artist on Gadigal land, and will have their television debut later this year on STAN's "Bad Behaviour".
