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Liv is a Neurodivergent artist with Synesthesia. She began her acting pursuits in the theatre, where she auditioned for and was selected for the Wa Youth Theatre Company's Youth Ensemble for 2015/16. Liv worked and trained with WAYTCO's Artistic Director Renato Fabretti, and some of Perth's most reputable acting coaches. During her time here, she was cast as the lead role for the ensembles Fringe World Festival production "On the face Of Things." Since then, Liv has trained in theatre and screen completing numerous master classes and courses including WAAPA, NIDA, WAYTCO, Ali Roberts Acting Studio, Perth Acting Centre (PAC) Annie Murtagh - Monks, and more. She has been elected as a member for WAYTCO's Youth Advisory Committee. She will act as an ambassador and advocate in the development of future projects.

Liv played Alice in the feature film 'Alexander', it premiered at Luna Leederville Cinema in October 2020, and Palace Cinema for Fringe World 2021. She has been cast as 'Dawn' one of the main cult members who's ruthless in her lust for violence in Gods and Kings Productions latest feature 'The sacrifice.'

Her recent career highlights include; playing the lead acting opposite 80's icon and Mad Max's 'Goose' Steve Bisley, in 'Same Time Monday.' The film was officially selected by The Revelation Film festival and was screened at The Backlot Perth, and Luna Cinema over four days in July 2021. Liv's latest short 'Broken Promises' written and directed by Sally Newman, has been officially selected by the WA Made Film Festival, and will screen to audiences in March 2022.

Liv is passionate about interesting, unusual, unique and complex roles that reconfigure the status quo of gender in film; where the notion of normalcy, conventionality, and the expected, is challenged. She enjoys exploring all avenues of the human psyche, and is fascinated by the many archetypal roles we all embody and play in life. Liv has a plethora of skills, including accent abilities, expansive breadth of emotional range, and she excels in character acting.

Liv is a multidimensional artist. She utilises Stanislavski, method acting, and meditative techniques with her approaches to roles. Liv is a funny, hard working, empathetic, inclusive, inquisitive, person. She advocates for women's rights, animal rights, youth mental health, and is an Ally of the LGBTQQIA+ community.

Liv was chosen to be featured as a 'rising creative' in the first issue of Performers Connect Magazine, which is Australia's first online industry magazine dedicated to showcasing Australia's upcoming talent. It gives chosen actors the platform to showcase their work to casting directors, and directors, in the Entertainment industry.
