

With a diploma in screen acting (Film and Television Institute) and a BFA in Music theatre (Victorian College of the Arts), Kaori has appeared as a series regular on the Australian soap, Neighbours in the role of Jasmine Udagawa and alongside Nazeem Hussain on his comedy skit show, Orange Is The New Brown as well as numerous short films. On stage, Kaori has the pleasure to sing with people such as accomplished Broadway composer, John Bucchino, as a soloist in a concert of his work and alongside such Australian icons as John Waters, Tim Freedman and Brian Mannix in the cast of PARIS – A Rock Odyssey. In 2019, Kaori was part of the original Australian cast of Lazarus playing the role of Maemi presented by The Production Company.

Though 2020 was a tough year for artists everywhere, Kaori kept herself busy being invited to be a collaborative artist in the Antipodes Theatre Company's Winter Development Retreat working shopping new works from artists such as Max Brown. She also had the pleasure of being invited to perform in the Melbourne Fringe Festival in a self-devised piece that she directed and produced herself.
