Biography

Jordan Russell is an Australian soprano and multifaceted performer whose artistry bridges opera, musical theatre, contemporary music, and film. She has trained internationally at institutions including Lyric Opera Studio Weimar, Vienna Opera Academy, and the American Musical and Dramatic Academy (New York), refining her craft across genres and disciplines.

On the operatic stage, Jordan has appeared as Barbarina (*Le Nozze di Figaro*, Lyric Opera Weimar), Bianca (*La Rondine*, Scheggino Opera), and Lauretta (*Gianni Schicchi*, Scheggino Opera), with festival engagements in Vienna and Italy. Her musical theatre repertoire includes Emma (*Jekyll and Hyde*), Laurie (*The Tender Land*), and Maria (*West Side Story*), showcasing her versatility across both classical and contemporary roles.

Her concert and ensemble work includes appearances with Sydney Philharmonia Choirs (VOX) and performances in cabaret and crossover concerts in Sydney and New York. Under the artist name Jordy Burns, Jordan also writes and records original music, with her sophomore single *Second Chances* featured on triple J.

A prizewinner at multiple 2025 Australian aria competitions, Jordan is equally recognised as an accomplished cellist and trumpeter. Celebrated for her musicianship, stage presence, and expressive range, she continues to expand her international career across opera houses, concert stages, and recording studios.
