Annie Byron is an AFI Award-winning Australian film, stage, and television actress best known for Wolf Creek 2, Fran, Muriel's Wedding, and Doing Time for Patsy Cline. Other film roles include Nut Farm (recently filmed in Queensland and soon to be released), Slam, The View of Greenhaven Drive, Silver City, Lawrence of Arabia – The Master Illusionist, Letters, Big Jack Creek, The Third Wave, How Wonderful and the short films Ruby, Glory and Six O'Clock Swill.

Television roles are numerous and include: *Drop Dead Weird 1 & 2, Doctor Doctor, Growing Up Gracefully, Home & Away, All Saints, Stingers, Always Greener, Backberner, Stepfather of the Bride, Postcard Bandit, Flying Doctors, Death Duties, The Potato Factory, Clowning Around, Shadows of the Heart, Princess Kate, Displaced Persons, Uncle Dear Uncle, The Sullivans, A Country Practice, Prime Time, The Facts of Life Downunder, Rafferty's Rules, Flying Doctors, Great Expectations, GP, Five Mile Creek and Mary McKillop.*
