Peter Browne

Peter Browne attended UNSW School of Drama in the mid 1970s then applied to NIDA, graduating in 1980.

His first professional engagement was in Albury with the Murray River Performing Group where he performed in plays, theatre restaurant and sketch comedy shows in 1981 and 1982. A feature of the work he and the other actors performed was that they wrote their own shows, experimenting with all forms of humour and audience engagement.

Returning to Sydney in 1983, he was cast in numerous TVCs, TV shows and a few films.

Equally at home in comedy and drama roles, he enjoyed many wonderful opportunities in a diverse range of Australian TV shows in the 1980s and 90s.

He was cast in featured roles in ANZACS and Sword of Honour, had a continuing role in the first Police Rescue series, played multiple characters in the second series of Australia You're Standing In It, was the male lead in the gut wrenching drama Custody and brought to life the cantankerous character Alfred the Hot Water Bottle in more than 70 episodes of the ground breaking, world wide children's series Johnson and Friends, recorded in Australia and New Zealand for Film Australia and ABC.

He was also cast in many TVCs, mostly in comic roles and mostly as either a naïve Aussie bloke or variations of the laconic Aussie larrikin.

In the 1990s, Peter formed a small troupe of writer performers creating comedy shows for sport and corporate audiences, performing at major Rugby League and Cricket events and testimonial dinners and at conferences for big brands including IBM, Vodafone, Merck Sharp and Dohme, Bankers Trust and National Mutual.

He also started creating and producing corporate events around the turn of the century and then lived and worked in Singapore for 16 years, working in corporate communication and eventually, communication and presentation training and coaching.

He returned to Sydney in late 2019, just in time for the drought, fires, floods and the COVID pestilence in early 2020..

For a long time he has felt the itch to return to his acting origins and is now delighted to join Duke Actors Management.

While the sweet bird of youth has long departed, his energy is still boundless, and his wry humour and empathy are more deeply ingrained.
