Josef is perhaps most well known for his series role of Dominic in the critically acclaimed television show, *Rush* for Network TEN/Southern Star, and a recurring role on *McLeod's Daughters* for the Nine Network.

Josef's extensive television credits include: *Redfern Now- series 2, ANZAC Girls, Devils Dust, Tricky Business, Wild Boys, Rescue Special Ops, East West 101, Love My Way, Wildside, Water Rats, Murder Call, Home & Away, Young Lions, The Alice, and Australia: The Story of Us.* Josef's most notable film credits include the role of Joe Byrne in 2002 feature of *Ned*, directed by Abe Forsythe. *The Junction Boys* for Fox Productions in USA, ESPN TV and the role of Clay in the thriller *Powderburn*, directed by Steven Prime.

Josef's career on stage has been equally expansive having starred in productions such as *Grease* for The Gordon Frost Organization, which saw him tour Australia and New Zealand; *The Tempest* for The Bell Shakespeare Company; *Lobby Hero* for The Ensemble Theatre; *The Laramie Project, Frozen* and *Run Rabbit Run* for Company B, Belvoir; *Responsive Project #2* for the Sydney Theatre Company; *My First Time,* Sydney Opera House, directed by Wayne Harrison; *Tiger Country*, and *Porn Cake* for Griffin Theatre. He most recently played the role of Rabbit in the critically acclaimed Darlinghurst Theatre Company production of *Savages*, directed by Tim Rosman in 2016.

Most recently Josef can be seen in the reoccurring role of Robbie in series 2 of *Janet King*, directed by Peter Andrikidis; as Detective Will Shepherd in *Home & Away* and the soon to be released mini series, *Brock* as James McIntosh, directed by Geoff Bennett, and in the feature film, *Down Under*.
