#### **JANE**

(tentative) Sorry if I'm a bit jetlagged.

## **NICOLETTE**

It's crazy you just flew in from England. Hope you had points.

# <u>JANE</u>

Not really, but things felt a bit... unfinished, after last time -

Nicolette's wary.

### **NICOLETTE**

I didn't actually believe the Doc when he said you wanted to talk to me... Wasn't too sure I wanted to see you, either.

# **JANE**

I know. I feel awful about what happened. I could have handled things better in Perth. (beat) I'm sorry.

Nicolette's thrown.

### <u>JANE</u>

You were my guest. We were having a rather nice time and...I threw you out. I shouldn't have done that.

### **NICOLETTE**

Wow. Okay. (beat) I'm sorry too.

Jane softens, relieved. Feeling for her mum, Nicolette feels compelled to explain herself.

### NICOLETTE

I was worried, Mum. I know I was pretty blunt about it -

# <u>JANE</u>

(dry) Blunt is an understatement. Nicolette concedes. It is true.

### **NICOLETTE**

You know me. If you're going rush into marrying someone - for literally no good reason - there's no way I could stay silent about it.

## <u>JANE</u>

(sl. affronted) You haven't changed your tune then.

# **NICOLETTE**

Why would I? I was right. You've broken up already. The whole thing was a bonkers idea.

And there's that bluntness again. Jane grows defensive.

### JANE

It might have helped if you'd given Des a chance. You showed up already determined to poke holes in our relationship.

Nicolette's stunned by Jane's turn.

### NICOLETTE

It's not like they were hard to find.

#### **JANE**

You really upset him, the poor man. He didn't deserve that. He's only ever been sweet and kind.

# **NICOLETTE**

I don't care about him. You were the one I was trying to look out for. If you guys were meant to be, nothing I said would've made a difference. You'd have managed to work it out.

#### <u>JANE</u>

You don't know that. How would you feel if I started interfering in your love life?

## **NICOLETTE**

I'd be shocked you even knew who I was dating. It's not like you ever shown any of interest -

## <u>JANE</u>

Nicolette -

### NICOLETTE

No. You haven't given a damn about me since I came out.

# **JANE**

(hurt) So is that what this was about? You punishing me for that time. Have you been waiting ten years just to get back at me?

Nicolette pauses, wildly offended.

# **NICOLETTE**

You actually think that?

Jane doesn't, but it's hard to back down now. She stays silent.

## NICOLETTE

I knew this was stupid. There's no point either of us being here.

And with that, she walks out, leaving a shaken Jane in her wake.
