ROSE

He's my husband... well, ex husband nearly. We're getting the D word.

He's thrown.

TOADIE

You never said you were married.

ROSE

Because I don't feel like I am. He's trying to hide all his assets so I don't even get a fair settlement.

TOADIE

You came to work for me so you could snoop on him?

It's sad for her to admit, but true.

<u>ROSE</u>

Fifteen years of marriage and I get left with nothing, that's his plan. I think he's funneling everything that's worth anything into this Anaconda shell company.

TOADIE

You think?

ROSE

You're the lawyer. You know where his

ROSE

I won't even be able to buy myself a coffee at this rate.

He makes a reluctant decision.

TOADIE

Give me that file. You can't see it. And I have to tell him you did this.

ROSE

What? No. Please.

TOADIE

Legal ethics.

ROSE

He'll use it against me. I'll probably end up owing him money.

TOADIE

I'm sorry for what you're going through but I can't help you with this. I can't let you keep working here either.

ROSE

How will I live?

TOADIE

There's other jobs.

She can see it's costing him, but he's set on it. No point arguing any further. ROXY Okay, I understand. (then) I'm sorry, Toadie.
